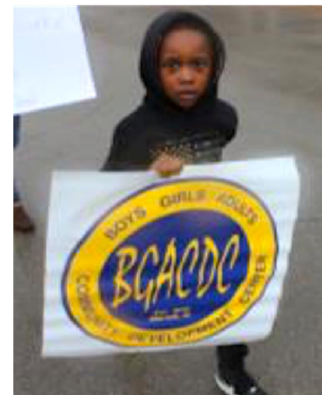


IT RAINED ON, BUT DIDN'T STOP, OUR PARADE
